Immigration Battle Spills Over into States

The battle to secure America's border and control illegal immigration has expanded . . . from Washington, D.C. to individual states.

Open borders advocates are working furiously to establish more "sanctuary cities", impede law enforcement operations aimed at rounding up illegals and even hand out driver's licenses to illegals.

"If anyone thought the battle over illegal im-

migration was over or even dying down they are wrong," says U.S. Border Security Council Executive Director Brice Griffin. "If anything the battle has expanded. The open borders lobby will not give up," she explains.

For example, in New York state, Governor Elliot Spitzer has made handing out driver's licenses to illegal immigrants one of his top legislative priorities. Gov.

Tunnels and Terrorists Along the Border: Can Anything Be Done?

Securing the U.S. Mexican border is much more difficult than it looks.

Drug cartels and immigrant smugglers have mastered much of the difficult desert terrain placing border patrol agents at a severe disadvantage.

"The criminal element along the border is

extremely clever," says U.S. Border Security Council Executive Director Brice Griffin. "They will spend whatever it takes in money, time and manpower in order to get into America."

Last fall U.S. officials uncovered yet another series of tunnels under construction under the border and into Arizona.

One of them was built directly under an official border crossing gate, literally right under the feet of U.S. officials.

Since 2001, more than 40 tunnels have been discovered running under the border. "The tunnels are clearly a huge problem," says Griffin. "However, (Continued on page 3)

Mexico Meets Oregon

Some Oregon public schools are adopting the official public school curriculum of Mexico in order to teach spanish-speaking students. Students receive books, DVDs and access to a special website.

ACLU Defends Illegal Hiring Employers

The American Civil Liberties Union is once again riding to the rescue of employers who are hiring illegal immigrants.

In some parts of California employers who wish to hire workers from official day laborer sites must obtain a special permit. The ACLU is desperately trying to keep the names of these employers secret even though most of the people they are employing are in this country illegally.



how people are invading our country is less important than who is sneaking across the border.

A recent government report leaked to the news media claims that Mexican drug cartels have been forged an alliance with Middle Eastern terrorist groups and are helping smuggle militants into America.

The terrorists then assume the identities of Mexican or Central American immigrants so they can move around the country more freely.

“After decades of neglecting security along our southern border, we have a lot of catching up to do, explains Griffin. “The fence is a great start and it is long in coming. But these smugglers and terrorists

are smart. They know the border regions well and they have the resources to stay one step ahead of our security agencies,” she adds.

“It’s truly unfortunate that only now, over six years since the September 11th attacks, are we begin-

ning to secure the border,” Griffin elaborates. “Even to this day the Bush Administration doesn’t take border security seriously. Whatever they are now doing is only in response to the massive outcry of ordinary Americans and the supporters of the U.S. Border Security Council.”

To demonstrate her point Griffin notes that Homeland Security Secretary Michael Chertoff recently remarked that he supports building the border fence because it will be good for the environment. “Illegal migrants really degrade the environment. I’ve seen pictures of human waste, garbage, discarded bottles and other human artifact in pristine areas,” Chertoff said. “And believe me, that is the worst thing you can do to the environment.”

shadows ... (and) allow them to participate in the economy,” Motor Vehicles Commissioner David Swarts said to USA Today.

New Haven, Connecticut is already handing out ID cards to everyone, including illegal immigrants. The cards are considered official identification and can be used by terrorists seeking to secure airline tickets or open bank accounts.

“It really is incredible that elected officials, people who are charged with protecting our lives and property, would go to such great lengths to not only reward, but to encourage illegal behavior,” says Griffin.

However, the battle is not simply confined to government issued IDs. Local government benefits and day labor sites are also sparking pitched battles.

In the suburbs of Washington, DC the open borders lobby and citizen activists are involved in a running battle that crosses state borders and is making national headlines.

What started out as a citizen’s revolt aimed at closing down a day-laborer site in the town of Herndon, Virginia has spilled over into nearby Prince William County, Virginia where the local government is desperately fighting to use the police to help round up illegals.

The county has endured one economic boycott and is constantly under attack by members of the left wing media. Now politicians in Maryland have even joined the

battle belittling their neighbors’ attempts to control illegal immigration. In a recent radio Montgomery County Maryland County Executive “Ike” Leggit claimed Virginians were less “enlightened” on the issue of doling out benefits to illegals.

Leggit’s county, which is located just a few miles from the National Mall in Washington, DC is known for its day laborer centers teaming with illegal immigrants and for doling out millions of dollars in government benefits to illegals.

“It’s great some state’s are stepping up and fighting back against the illegal alien invasion and their lobby,” says Brice Griffin. “However, there are still too many politicians out there in the state who want to reward illegal behavior.”

Border Security Talking Points

Open borders advocates love to use myths and outright falsehoods to push their pro-illegal alien policies. Here are just a few facts and figures you can use when debating the urgent need for border security:

☆ Currently 11.5% of the population of the United States is foreign born.

☆ Thanks to illegal immigration the number of immigrants residing in the U.S. is more than double what it was in 1910.

☆ From 2000-2004 the largest increases in immigrant employment were in Los Angeles, Washington, D.C., Dallas, Houston, New York, and Seattle.

☆ Illegal immigrants in 2004 accounted for 95 percent of all outstanding arrest warrants for murder in Los Angeles.

☆ According to one private report, the rate of illegals entering the United States increased 25% in response to President Bush's 2004 "guest worker" proposal.

☆ 17% of all inmates in *federal* prisons are illegal immigrants.



☆ Almost 20% of all living native-born Mexicans are now residing in the United States.
