Council to Meet Reid's Immigration Pledge Head-On

Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid recently announced that he wants to pass an Amnesty for illegal aliens bill during this Congress and preferably before Christmas.

But the U.S. Border Security Council is one step ahead of him and has already launched a nationwide effort to stop any and all attempts to pass an amnesty bill.

In a recent interview, Reid declared that passing an amnesty bill is "going to happen this ses-

sion, but I want it this year if at all possible."

Last winter, Executive Director Brice Griffin, in a letter to supporters across the nation, warned that the illegal alien lobby wanted an amnesty bill this year.

"The pressure on Congressional supporters of amnesty from the illegal alien lobby is simply too great for the politicians to ignore," Griffin explains.

Mexican Border Town Angry Over Return of Illegal Immigrants

Officials in the Mexican town of Agua Prieta located on the U.S.-Mexican border, are vowing to retaliate against the United States because American immigration officials are repatriating illegal aliens to their town.

The officials are furious that scores of illegal aliens who are deported by U.S. immigration agents are dumped back into their town without warning or the town's permission.

To retaliate, the town's leaders are training their fellow countrymen how to sneak into the United States and then manipulate the legal system to remain in the United States as long as possible.

"What this Mexican town is trying to do is gum up the American courts with illegal aliens because they're mad that America is enforcing some of its immigration laws,"

Border Security News in Brief

Another Innocent Killed By Illegal Alien

4-year-old Josiah Bluhm was killed outside of Omaha, Nebraska by illegal alien Eleazar Rangel-Ochoa, who was driving under the influence of alcohol. The illegal alien had been denied before from receiving a driver's license for not having a valid social security number and arrested for a misdemeanor DUI twice. The Douglas County police department said that they could not contact U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement because the case was not a major felony.

Activists Want Detention Centers Closed

Illegal immigrant supporters are calling for the Obama administration to close family detention centers, where aliens are placed as they await trial. They contend that children, who remain in these centers as a result of their parents' actions, should not be forced to be kept as prisoners. If the parents had come to the United States the proper way, their children would not be locked in these facilities like felons.

Children Being Used as Bait Along Border

A special operative division of the U.S. Army reports that drug cartels are now using children as bait to smuggle drugs across the border. Children are lodged into gaps along the border fence and pretend to be stuck. As rescuers widen the holes to save these children, drug smugglers will take advantage of the vulnerable breaches in the border to sneak their goods into the country.

U.S. Senator Chuck Schumer is this month's "Sneak of the Month" for declaring that the U.S.-Mexico border is now secure.

In an attempt to justify pushing for a blanket amnesty for all illegal aliens Schumer stated that, "The border is far more secure than it's ever been."

Unfortunately for Mr. Shumer, the border remains unsecure. Drug dealers from

Mexico are still conducting raids into the United States and many members of Shumer's own political party want to dismantle what border security programs are currently in place including the border fence.

“I realized that early this year. While many pundits in D.C. were claiming that an immigration reform bill might be postponed, the U.S. Border Security Council was planning for battle.”

According to Griffin the Council is already receiving thousands of signed petitions opposing Senator Reid’s “Amnesty Plus” bill, S.9.

“We have grassroots campaigns aimed at pressuring both Congress and the state governors to oppose S.9 running right now,” explains Griffin. “We are more prepared than ever to put incredible heat on the politicians to defeat this amnesty proposal.”

S.9, or “Amnesty Plus” as the Council calls it, is a bill sponsored by Harry Reid that Reid says will not only grant amnesty to illegals but will relax immigration restric-

tions on individuals associated with terrorist groups, and tear down the new fence along the U.S.-Mexican border.

According to Reid, “. . . I believe we would be wise to reconsider the effectiveness and cost of a wall along our southern border, which has adversely affected the fragile environment and vibrant

cross-border culture of an entire region . . .”

These politicians have every intention of ramming this crazy bill down the throats of ordinary Americans,” say Griffin. “They know amnesty is unpopular but they don’t care. All they care about is buying the votes of hispanics with this lunacy.”

The U.S. Border Security Council will continue fighting this amnesty bill regardless of whether or not the Congress has started deliberating it.

“I have no intention of waiting for Congress to make the first move on this,” Griffin warns. “We are fighting like crazy right now. I don’t want this awful bill to ever even get to the floor of the House.”

explains U.S. Border Security Council Executive Director Brice Griffin. “The citizens of Agua Prieta don’t want these lawbreakers in their town any more than Americans want them in our country.”

The solution Griffin says is not to make the illegal immigration situation worse for Americans. “Agua Prieta needs to fight back against the Mexican federal government,” she says. “It is their government’s policy of exporting millions and millions of their poorest citizens to the United States that is causing this problem.

“This situation also shows how easy it is for foreigners to manipulate our own legal system for their purposes,” Griffin warns. “In this case, a Mexican town of 130,000

people has a realistic chance of tying up our court system with illegal aliens who are armed with lawyers and want their day in court. The result is that illegal aliens can be used as a type of weapon against us.”

Griffin says the United States

cannot let this border town dictate our national immigration policy. “The U.S. State Department should immediately confront the Mexican national government and have it stop Agua Prieta’s city government from helping the illegals. This is a matter of national security.

“Then U.S. immigration officials should step up their deportation efforts and not shy away from returning people to Agua Prieta. If the citizens of that town don’t like it, they should take up the matter with their representatives in Mexico City.”

Pro-Illegal Alien Pressure Group Poll Says Hispanics Want Amnesty

A poll commissioned by the pro-illegal alien group America's Voice reports that 87% of American hispanics will not vote for any politician who supports forcing illegal aliens to leave the country.

The poll also states that 69% of American Hispanics actually know someone who is in the United States illegally.

“This poll is part of a strategy to scare politicians into supporting amnesty,” explains U.S. Border Security Council Executive Director Brice Griffin. “This group wants the world to think that amnesty is wildly popular and that anyone who doesn't support it will pay a

high political price.”

The poll did not include any non-Hispanic Americans.

“I know from our own sources that Amnesty is wildly unpopular,” Griffin says. “However, the pro-illegal alien lobby will do anything to convince Congress that it has public support.”

According to the poll, 83% of American Hispanics believe that President Obama will get an amnesty bill passed this year.

“That is a figure that is probably correct,” laughs Griffin. “The President is firmly in the pro-illegal alien camp.”
