Illegal Alien Lobby Leans On New New York Senator

As a Member of congress, Kirsten Gillibrand was a staunch supporter of efforts to crack down on illegal aliens. However, in response to a massive public relations campaign by illegal alien advocates, now U.S. Senator Gillibrand is changing her mind.

Gillibrand was recently appointed to the U.S. Senate to complete the term of Hillary Clinton, who resigned to be Secretary of State. In Congress, Gillibrand represented upstate New York and supported penalizing sanctuary cities like New York City and prohibiting illegal aliens from receiving discounted tuition at public universities.

However, in the face of massive pressure from immigration groups that threatened to work to defeat Gillibrand's reelection effort, she changed her mind.

"The pro-illegal alien lobby jumped all over Gillibrand the second she was appointed to the Senate," explains U.S. Border Security Council Executive Director Brice Griffin. "They threatened her. They began recruiting an opponent to challenge her for reelection and then began rallying their troops from the barrios of New York City. And unfortunately, Senator Gilli-

Immigration Raids Spark Political Controversy

Obama administration officials and pro-illegal alien activists are demanding an investigation into a Department of Homeland Security raid in Washington State that arrested twenty-eight illegal aliens. The administration pledged to stop raids aimed at enforcing America's immigration laws.

According to the *New York Times*, a senior official at the

Department of Homeland Security claimed that Secretary of Homeland Security Janet Napolitano did not know of the raid ahead of time and would have stopped it if she had learned of it.

According to the aide, "She was not happy about it because it's inconsistent with her position, and the President's position on these

Border Security News in Brief

A decorated Iraqi War veteran is suing the city of Phoenix and its police department after he was stabbed by a recently deported illegal alien. The veteran nearly died after being stabbed in the chest while standing on his front lawn. The lawsuit claims the city and the police were negligent in enforcing immigration laws. The suspect had a warrant issued for his arrest at the time of the stabbing.

A recent court ruling says citizens may detain illegal aliens who are trespassing on their land. Arizona rancher Roger Barnett detained a number of illegal aliens at gunpoint and was then sued by a pro-illegal alien lawyers group that represented the trespassers. The aliens demanded \$32 million but a judge dismissed their lawsuit explaining that citizens may arrest illegal aliens. A jury ruled that Barnett, however, is still responsible for paying the illegal aliens \$77,000 in damages.

Phoenix, Arizona, has the second highest rate of kidnappings in the world, says a recent report. Drug dealers from Mexico have begun operations in the Arizona city.

According to one report, parts of the U.S. - Mexico border were closed on February 18 by U.S. officials in response to fighting in Mexico. U.S. colleges have also issued warnings to students planning to travel to Mexico on spring break to be wary about the ongoing civil strife down south.

brand seems to be giving in.”

Pro-illegal alien activists, especially in big cities, have a near stranglehold on the Democratic party. They provide massive amounts of money and volunteers for politicians who support their radical agenda.

“Gillibrand was a fairly reliable ally of border security in the House of Representatives,” Griffin explains. “However, then she represented a fairly middle class, politically moderate and economically distressed constituency,” Griffin explains. “Now that she’s in the Senate she has to contend with all the illegal aliens and their supporters in New York City. I suppose their threats were just too much for her to ignore.”

Gillibrand’s example shows just how powerful the pro-illegal alien

lobby is in this country and why, despite widespread public support for cracking down on illegal aliens, the Federal government is resistant to act.

Local Democratic party organizations are owned by their supporters, and primary elections are often swamped by bus loads of illegal alien activists who go door-to-door

matters.”

“The Secretary of Homeland Security, who is responsible for enforcing our nation’s immigration laws not only wants her department to not enforce the law, but she is going to investigate and probably fire whoever did, in fact do his job,” complains Brice Griffin, the U.S. Border Security Council’s Executive Director. “What other laws does Janet Napolitano not like and will refuse to enforce?”

The National Council of La Raza, complained openly about the raid declaring that their political support for President Obama’s election was predicated on the fact that he promised to stop immigration raids.

“President Obama has unilaterally declared the United States to be a ‘Sanctuary Country,’” says Brice Griffin.

“What we have here is an interest group, La Raza, that makes no secret of its allegiance to Mexico, and is declaring that it made a crooked deal with a U.S. President. In exchange for their political support, the President would refuse to

turning out the pro-illegal alien vote.

“These activists and these pressure groups are who we have to defeat,” explains Griffin. “Our side cannot afford to let these radicals intimidate our elected officials. We have to keep fighting back.

“The U.S. Border Security Council has already launched a number of efforts to hold the line against President Obama and his illegal alien-loving allies,” Griffin says. “I believe we can stop their attempt to implement ‘Amnesty-Plus’ although it’s going to be a brawl. I’m not sure how Senator Gillibrand will vote on this issue but we are going to work on getting her vote.”

implement the law,” Griffin says.

The U.S. Border Security Council will be making a major effort to pressure members of Congress to force the Obama administration to do its job.

“I don’t care what President Obama thinks of our immigration laws. It is his duty to enforce them. He could ask Congress to repeal the immigration laws but he’ll never get that. So, he’s simply appointed himself King and is ignoring the laws he doesn’t like,” complains Griffin. “President Obama has unilaterally declared the United States to be a ‘Sanctuary Country.’”
