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Obama Admin "Desperate" to Appease Illegals Says Council

“The Obama Administration is desperate to pass an illegal alien amnesty bill soon. However, growing public opposition to the idea as well as Obama’s sinking poll numbers are panicking the White House,” declared U.S. Border Security Council Executive Director Brice Griffin in a recent statement.

“The President is making all kinds of promises and is even contradicting himself on his timeline to push his amnesty bill,” Griffin says. “Clearly, our grassroots ef-

fort to kill amnesty before it can ever get a vote is working.

Griffin is referring to the thousands and thousands of Americans who have signed petitions and made phone calls protesting the President’s drive to allow millions of illegal aliens to remain in the United States legally.

“We have seen an enormous outpouring of support over the last few months,” Griffin explains.

S.9 Update: Fourteen Senators Sign onto “Amnesty Plus”

While President Obama is still dithering on whether or not to push forward with his pro-illegal alien agenda, Senate Democrats are slowly lining up support for Senator Harry Reid’s “Amnesty Plus” bill.

So far thirteen Democrat Senators have signed up as cosponsors of the radical bill that will grant amnesty, gut border security and allow terrorists into the United States.

“Thirteen cosponsors means that with the addition of Senator Reid,

who is the sponsor of the bill, the Democrats already have over one-quarter of the votes they need to pass this bill publicly campaigning for it,” says U.S. Border Security Council Executive Director Brice Griffin.

Wisconsin Taxpayers to Subsidize College for Illegals

Illegal immigrants will now be able to attend a state university in Wisconsin and will have to pay only in-state tuition, according to a new Wisconsin law. An illegal alien has traditionally had to pay out-of-state tuition, but, if a high school student who is an alien resides in the state for three years or more, then he or she will no longer have to pay that tuition rate. Wisconsin is the eleventh state to pass such a law.

Houston Policy Results in Another Police Officer Death

Houston's 17 year old "don't-ask-don't-tell" immigration policy has caused a third city officer since 2007 to lose his life after Roberto Pedroza Carrillo, an illegal alien, shot officer Henry Canales during a sting operation. Carillo had been formerly cited four times since 2004 for traffic violations and deported over a decade ago after being taken into custody in El Paso. Under Houston Police Department policy, police officers are not allowed to ask about someone's immigration status, even for minor offenses.

Chinese Immigrant Smuggling Ring Busted

Laing Yang of Duluth, Georgia has been convicted of harboring illegal aliens and finding them jobs for a fee. United States Attorney David E. Nahmias reported that Yang, along with four others, found jobs for illegal immigrants at Chinese restaurants up and down the East Coast. After an investigation, it was discovered that Yang harbored over 100 immigrants in just a 4 month period.

SNEAK OF THE MONTH: United States Senator John Cornyn

U.S. Senator John Cornyn (R-TX), is this month's "Sneak of the Month" for his comments urging President Obama to make "Comprehensive Immigration Reform" a top priority of his administration.

"Today President Obama backtracked on his promise to address comprehensive immigration reform during his first year in office," Cornyn said in a statement released by his

office. "After stating several times on the campaign trail that it would be a 'top priority,' I am disappointed he has changed his tune."

Cornyn, in the past has supported a vigorous "guest worker program" for immigrants.

“Our plan to preempt amnesty is working. The U.S. Border Security Council has doubled its supporter base this year and the politicians are running scared.”

President Obama finds himself in a difficult spot. On one hand he promised the illegal alien lobby he will ram an amnesty bill through Congress this year. On the other hand he is being hammered by ordinary citizens who vehemently oppose his plans.

“The White House is totally confused,” Griffin says. “On one hand the President says he has too much on his plate and amnesty will have to wait until next year. On the other hand he’s trying keep his illegal alien allies happy.”

The problem has become particularly acute in recent weeks.

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House is becoming increasingly concerned about public opposition to this bill and they haven’t given the go ahead, yet.”

Griffin says that in the Senate it could be very tough to stop Reid’s bill. “We estimate that Reid will have a solid 50 votes comprised of a vast majority of Democrats plus some Republicans who will vote to pass S.9,” she explains. “The question is, can we get 41 votes to sustain a filibuster? Right now, I am not so sure.”

Hope for defeating this bill may actually reside in the House of Representatives.

During a recent trip to Mexico the President proclaimed that an amnesty bill will have to wait until next year because health care, climate change and financial regulation legislation are more important.

However, during the same trip the President also urged Congress to have a bill written and ready to go by the end of the year.

“The Democrats and some of their illegal alien-loving Republican allies are ready to go with this bill once the White House gives them a sign,” Griffin explains.

“Every member of the House is up for reelection in 2010 so they will be more cautious about jumping on the amnesty bandwagon,” says Griffin. “We may be able to stop the bill there if

“The President can’t have it both ways,” says Griffin. “He can’t both postpone the bill -- which will likely kill it since no one wants to vote on an amnesty bill in an election year -- and force Congress to act this year. Either way, we are ready for him.”

Griffin says this situation in one way is very unfortunate. “The President should make border security his number one issue and put aside all these other issues. Protecting the nation and making all the illegal aliens go home should be on the agenda this year,” she says.

we have enough grassroots support.”

“The key is to continue to flood Congress with petitions and phone calls and to convince the politicians to give up on the issue,” Griffin says. “Therefore, I need all our supporters to sign every petition and letter of protest I send them. It is crucial that we do not let up now.”

For its part, the Council is working overtime to make sure that there is a steady flow of correspondence from the American people to Capitol Hill. “We have another group of petitions heading up to Capitol Hill any day now,” says Griffin.

The President's Illegal Alien Aunt Living It Up on Taxpayer's Dime

Zeituni Polly Onyango, the half-sister of President Barack Obama's late father Barack Obama Sr., has recently moved into public housing in South Boston, six months before her deportation trial is set to begin on April 4, 2010.

In 2004, Onyango was ordered to be sent back to Africa after her request for asylum was denied, but she never left.

According to her request, she was trying to escape the violence in her home nation.

She was discovered to be living illegally in the United States during the last few weeks before the 2008 presidential election by *The Times*

of London.

The spokesperson for the Cleveland, Ohio-based legal firm representing Onyango is optimistic about the deportation trial.

Attorneys Margaret Wong and Scott Bratton have requested that the immigration trial not be held open to the public, said the spokeswoman for the Executive Office for Immigration Review, a division of the Department of Justice

During her interview, she commented relaxing on her porch wearing a relished green tattered dress that she claims her nephew, President Obama, gave her years ago: "(South Boston) is one of the most

beautiful places I've ever lived in."

Executive Director of the U.S. Border Security Council commented on the Onyango case, "President Obama's refusal to address the immigration issue regarding a member of his own family is a reflection of his overall lax attitude towards border enforcement in this country."

"Ms. Onyango will no doubt get preferential treatment and be allowed to stay in this country," Griffin adds. "However, the U.S. Border Security Council will fight to have this gold-digging woman sent back to her country."
