Obama Launches National Blitz To Pass Amnesty

Vowing to ram through some type of immigration amnesty this year, President Obama has launched the largest and most expensive pro-illegal alien lobbying campaign in American history.

The public relations blitz began with a series of meetings between Administration officials and members of Congress. It then moved to a more public phase and included a high-profile meeting between the President and pro-amnesty Hispanic celebrities.

Then the President promised his political allies that amnesty was at the very top of his agenda this year at a high profile and very vitriolic speech Obama gave at the U.S.-Mexican border in El Paso, Texas.

“There is no question that President Obama wants some type of amnesty to pass this year and he is pulling out all the stops to get it,” says U.S. Border Security Council National Spokesman Steven LeBlanc. “This a now a wholesale

Inside the Anti-Amnesty Battle:

LeBlanc Fears Shortage of Resources to Fight Back

The prospect of facing a multi-million dollar campaign to pass some type of amnesty for illegal aliens this year has U.S. Border Security Council National Spokesman Steve LeBlanc very worried.

“We’ve beaten every attempt to pass amnesty since the founding of the U.S. Border Security Council five years ago,” LeBlanc says. “However, we’ve never had to battle an entire Administration that

is committed to spending whatever it takes to pass an amnesty bill and that has the resources to spend tens-of-millions of dollars to do it.”

LeBlanc says that bad economy has hit the Council very hard and he has had to cut back on some grassroots programs already. “The fact is, the voluntary annual dues people pay only cover a small part

Border Security News in Brief

Number of Illegal Alien Arrests Plunges

According to federal officials, the number of arrests of people trying to cross the U.S.-Mexico border fell sharply during the last five years. In fiscal year 2010, officials arrested 447,731 illegal immigrants in the states bordering Mexico. These figures represent a 58 percent decrease from fiscal year 2006, when 1.07 million arrests were made.

Obama Ignores Texas Wildfires, Sends Help to Mexico Instead

The Obama Administration recently ordered two specially equipped Air Force planes to Mexico to help that disintegrating country fight wildfires that were raging out of control. Meanwhile, in Texas, wildfires raged for weeks destroying thousands of acres of property and prompting a state emergency declaration. To date, President Obama has refused to even declare Texas eligible for federal disaster assistance.

Thirteen Killed During Battle at Border Lake

Falcon Lake along the Texas-Mexico border, was the scene of yet another deadly shooting recently. In a gun battle between members of the Zeta's drug gang and Mexican "Marines," thirteen people were killed, twelve of them members of the Zetas and one a member of the Mexican "Marines." Picturesque Falcon Lake has become infamous for violent clashes between drug gangs and Mexican law enforcement officials. Last year, an American on a jet ski was executed by members of the Zetas.

SNEAK OF THE MONTH: Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid

This month's "Sneak of the Month" is Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid for his outrageous call for people to push for passage of the DREAM Act amnesty bill.

Reid, taking a cue from President Barack Obama, declared, "As was said yesterday in El Paso by the president, we need the people of America to rise up and indicate to each of us how important this legislation is," Reid said.

Reid has been serving as

the illegal-alien lobbies "go to man" in the Senate and his comments were clearly a call for pro-illegal alien activists and illegal aliens themselves to take to the streets in order to intimidate Congress into passing the DREAM Act amnesty bill. battle that the Administration plans to fight all across America.”

Obama’s Texas speech was one of the harshest and most pro-illegal alien speeches ever. The venue was carefully chosen -- a site right on the border and in a city where scores of illegal aliens and hispanic activists could be recruited to attend and cheer. Additionally, while the President was flanked by American flags on the stage, he was carefully positioned so that everyone in attendance could see a giant Mexican flag flying over Juarez, Mexico on the other side of the border.

“This was a campaign-style speech aimed at mobilizing open borders activists like never before,” warns LeBlanc. “The symbolism of the giant Mexican flag, the cheering activists and the harsh

rhetoric were all planned out by the White House political staff. They are going to wage a war over amnesty and they have every intention of winning it.”

“There is no question that President Obama wants some type of amnesty to pass this year and he is pulling out all the stops to get it,” says U.S. Border Security Council National Spokesman Steven LeBlanc.

In Obama’s speech, he made several outrageously false and inflammatory statements including a ridiculous claim that the border fence that Obama originally opposed is now complete.

The fact is, only a small part of

the border fence is actually complete and illegal aliens are still pouring across the border.

“The President’s argument is that the border is secure now so now it is time for amnesty,” LeBlanc explains. “The border isn’t secure though. In fact, violence is getting worse along the border and the Administration doesn’t care. The President just wants to legalize millions of immigrants before the 2012 election.”

LeBlanc promises the U.S. Border Security Council will fight back and oppose any type of amnesty, even a limited one for a specific group of illegal aliens. “This is a fight for the future of America,” he says. “No amnesty in any form will pass this Congress if the Council has anything to say about it.”

from our supporters to supplement those dues payments. This year, however, not only are those additional contributions way down, but we are now facing a do or die

battle against Barack Obama and what will likely be a \$10 million effort to force Congress to pass the DREAM Act amnesty bill.

The so-called “DREAM Act” is an amnesty for the children of illegal aliens and its passage is the first step in the Administration’s plan to grant amnesty to all illegal aliens before the 2012 elections. The President’s reelection campaign and the Democratic National Committee are already raising money specifically for this pro-amnesty effort. Immediately after Obama’s controversial speech in El Paso, Texas where he vowed to push amnesty through Congress, his political aides blanketed the country with fundraising emails urging his supporters to contribute to the pro-amnesty p.r. campaign.

“The fact is that not only does the Committee not have the resources to match Obama’s campaign effort, we really don’t have the money to put up much of a fight at all right now. We need to be running ads, holding rallies and sending people door-to-door on Capitol Hill. But thanks to Barack Obama’s lousy economy, we are having a tough time raising the money we need.”

LeBlanc says he will probably send out an emergency request for donations to the Council’s national network of supporters in the very near future. “We need help. To win this battle and stop amnesty, we need to raise more money and raise it quickly.”
