Council Urges Arizona to Press Ahead In Wake of Court Ruling

The U.S. Border Security Council is urging the state of Arizona to continue enforcing its popular immigration law in the wake of the Supreme Court's recent ruling upholding the measure and the Obama Administration's threat to stop cooperating with the state.

"This is a major decision that will have a profound impact on border security," explains Steve LeBlanc, the U.S. Border Security Council's National Spokesman. "Arizona wanted to be

able to enforce the immigration laws and check the immigration status of suspected illegal aliens and the high court supported that part of the law."

Immediately following the ruling, the Obama Administration declared that the Department of Homeland Security would no longer help Arizona law enforcement officials process illegal immigrants detained

"Flood Congress with Calls and Petitions" Says LeBlanc

The U.S. Border Security Council is launching its most aggressive grassroots lobbying campaign to date in response to the Obama Administration's determination to illegally extend amnesty to millions of illegal immigrants.

"We are sending out a huge number of petitions for our national network of supporters to sign and return," says Council National Spokesman Steve LeBlanc. "We need to flood Congress with calls

and petitions demanding that Capitol Hill rein in this out-of-control President."

The Council has always relied on massive petition campaigns and other grassroots lobbying programs to influence public policies. However, the stakes are now much higher.

"In the past, we've been able to pressure Congress and stop an am-

Border Security News in Brief

Voters Believe Government Encourages Illegals

Most voters continue to believe the federal government encourages rather than discourages illegal immigration. A new Rasmussen Reports national telephone survey finds that 58% of likely U.S. voters think the policies and practices of the federal government encourage illegal immigration. Just 24% disagree, while 18% more are undecided.

Model Receives "Genius Visa"

Shera Bechard, a model and former girlfriend of Playboy Magazine founder Hugh Hefner, recently received a special visa that the U.S. government reserves for "individuals with extraordinary ability."

Bechard was Playboy's Miss November in 2010 and evidently that qualified her for what is sometimes called a "genius visa." A great deal of lobbying from a high-priced "immigration lawyer" didn't hurt either.

Mexican Ambassador Blasts "Fast and Furious"

At a recent forum on Capitol Hill, Arturo Sarukhan, Mexico's ambassador to the U.S., complained that his government had been left in the dark about Justice Department undercover operations to stop gun smuggling at the border.

The Fast and Furious operation showed an "outstanding lack of understanding of how criminal organizations are operating on both sides of our common borders," he said

Former Florida Governor Jeb Bush is this month's "Sneak of the Month" for urging the Republican Party to cater to illegal aliens.

In a recent interview, Bush urged Republican Presidential nominee Mitt Romney put forth a "broader" message in order to appeal to Hispanic voters.

under the law.

“What President Obama is doing is unconscionable,” says LeBlanc. “The Supreme Court ruled that Arizona could perform these checks and the Administration is still trying to stop them. The Council wholeheartedly encourages the state of Arizona to keep enforcing the law no matter what the federal government says or does.”

Barack Obama has made undermining the nation’s border security and immigration laws a component of his reelection strategy. His recent illegal Presidential decree imposing the Dream Act amnesty sparked outrage across the nation and condemnation from the U.S. Border Security Council.

“In light of his recent actions,

it shouldn’t surprise anyone that Barack Obama is trying to prevent a state from cracking down on illegal aliens,” explains LeBlanc. “But this time, his

threats against Arizona look increasingly desperate. I believe our President is really feeling the political heat from taxpayers

who are fed up with his policies.”

As this month’s newsletter goes to print, the Obama Administration is still cooperating with local Arizona law enforcement officials.

Maricopa County, Arizona Sheriff Joe Arpaio reports that his deputies have detained and turned over to federal immigration officials a number of illegals since the President issued his threat.

“We encourage all local jurisdictions to keep enforcing this perfectly legal and constitutional law,” LeBlanc says. “The rest of the nation is looking to Arizona to stand up to the bully in the White House.”

nesty bill from passing,” LeBlanc explains. “During the Administration of George W. Bush, we fought a pitched battle against ‘comprehensive immigration reform’ and won. Because of that success, Barack Obama is simply ignoring Congress and refusing to enforce the nation’s immigration laws. That now makes our job that much tougher.”

LeBlanc explains that Congress will have to take very concrete action to force the Administration to enforce the laws it doesn’t like. “We are going to lobby Congress to hold public hearings and cut off funding for programs that the President wants,” he says. “Con-

gress is going to have to play hard ball or else Obama will continue to flout the law and do whatever he wants.”

That’s where the Council’s supporters come in.

all our supporters to sign the petitions we send them and to call or visit the offices of their Congressmen or Senators,” LeBlanc urges. “We have a very detailed strategy to absolutely overwhelm Congress and we need every single American who cares about border security to participate.”

Council supporters should be receiving the first of these new Congressional petitions in the mail in July and August. “Our goal is to begin delivering these petitions up to Capitol Hill in September, just before the elections when they will have the most impact,” says LeBlanc.


