Reid Blasts Grassroots Efforts to Stop Amnesty

Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid is blasting grassroots opponents of Senate Bill 6, called Amnesty Plus, and other immigration reform measures.

Reid's outburst was in response to his inability to ram through "comprehensive immigration reform" legislation because of massive grassroots pressure being applied to Senate Republicans.

During a conference call with

reporters Reid accused Republicans of "harshness, bitterness, meanness" and of "catering to the Tea Party."

"While the U.S. Border Security Council isn't a 'Tea Party' organization, we certainly are part of the grassroots movement opposing Amnesty Plus," says Council National Spokesman Steve LeBlanc.

Rubio Jumps Ship and Supports Dream Act Amnesty

Republican Senator and possible Vice Presidential candidate Marco Rubio now says he supports a version of the the Dream Act amnesty for illegal alien kids.

In a recent interview with Fox News personality Geraldo Rivero, a supporter of amnesty, Rubio declared, "I do want to help out these (illegal immigrant) kids. The Dream Act is a way to help them out."

The Dream Act is a bill designed to grant amnesty to illegal alien children. The Obama Administra-

tion has been effectively implementing this amnesty through relaxed enforcement ever since efforts to pass it through Congress failed.

Rubio previously described himself as a pro-border security or a "border security first" Republican.

"This betrayal is exactly why we have to keep fighting amnesty and why I keep telling our supporters that amnesty is not dead," warns U.S. Border Security Coun-

Border Security News in Brief

Romney Panders to Puerto Ricans

Republican Presidential Candidate Mitt Romney recently release and open letter to the people of Puerto Rico declaring that he, “will work to settle the Island’s 113-year political status question.” The odd statement seems to indicate that Romney would be open to Puerto Rico becoming the 51st state. A bill that would pave the way for Puerto Rican statehood was passed by the House of Representatives but not the Senate.

Bill Would Require the Automatic Deportation of Illegal Alien Drunk Drivers

The Subcommittee on Immigration Policy and Enforcement recently introduced H.R. 3808, the Scott Gardner Act, that would automatically deport illegal immigrants who are convicted of drunk driving. The bill, introduced by border security supporter Representative Sue Myrick, is designed to force federal officials to act despite stiff resistance from the pro-illegal alien lobby.

Kentucky Moves to Cut Off Illegal Alien Benefits

A proposal in Kentucky will ban illegal immigrants from getting welfare benefits. The measure has already passed the state house and is awaiting action in the Kentucky state senate.

The bill requires welfare applicants to present documentation of U.S. citizenship or legal residency in order to be eligible for the government benefits. Illegal alien supporters are opposing the measure.

SNEAK OF THE MONTH: San Antonio Independent School District

The leadership of the San Antonio Independent School District in Texas is this month’s “Sneak of the Month” for protesting chants of “USA, USA” at a high school basketball game.

San Antonio officials complained that fans from a rival school district were racist for celebrating their victory with the traditional patriotic cheer. Many of the players on the losing team from Edison High

School are Hispanic.

“It was chanted selectively at a school that is predominantly Hispanic and there was understanding of that,” whined San Antonio district spokesman Leslie Price. She claimed that many people who called her office found the “USA, USA” chant to be “very disrespectful.”

“I’ll take Mr. Reid’s hysterical comments as a compliment, Our grassroots campaigns are obviously making a difference.”

LeBlanc says the Council has been bombarding both the U.S. House and Senate with petitions opposing Reid’s amnesty bill and similar measures for the past year. “Harry Reid though he would have an easy time ramming S. 6 through the Democrat-controlled Senate. However, he didn’t count on the American people fighting back,”

So far, no immigration amnesty bill has made it to the floor of the Senate during this session of Congress and Reid is obviously frustrated.

“Our grassroots strategy has, so far, been able to keep Republicans and line and to scare a few politically vulnerable Democrats into ignoring the leaders of their own party,” LeBlanc explains. “I don’t
