Senate Amnesty Vote Likely This Summer

The U.S. Border Security Council is preparing to oppose a new, “Republican” version of the Dream Act Amnesty that is likely to be proposed this summer.


Senator Marco Rubio is reportedly working on the so-called compromise measure in an effort to boost Hispanic support for Republican candidates this fall

The compromise will likely include rewarding illegal alien fami-

lies that brought young children into the United States years ago with a special immigration status for those children.

“This is just another way of granting amnesty to a segment of the illegal alien population,” says Council National Spokesman Steve LeBlanc. “We are going to fight this bill and we are going to defeat it.”

LeBlanc Urges Passage of Contempt Citation of Holder

The U.S. Border Security Council is lending its voice to a growing chorus of Americans demanding that Attorney General Eric Holder be held in contempt of Congress.


A Contempt of Congress citation is currently being reviewed by House Republican leaders fed up with Holder’s refusal to cooperate with the investigation into the Fast and Furious scandal.

Holder has promised to cooper-

ate with Congressional inquiries, however, so far he has not turned over all the records his department has concerning the government drug-running scandal that resulted in the death of a Border Patrol Agent, Brian Terry.

“Enough is enough,” says Council National Spokesman Steve LeBlanc, “Eric Holder is deliberately trying to cover up his role in

Border Security News in Brief

Border Town Overwhelmed by Violence

The police headquarters in Nuevo Lared, Mexico was attacked by drug dealers who threw a grenade into the building just one day after seven people were killed in drug-related violence in that Mexican border city.

The violence in the border city is being blamed on a war between Los Zetas and the rival Sinaloa cartel, as well as the pressure being put on the Zetas leadership by the security forces.

Calderon Blasts U.S. Laws in Houston Speech

Mexican President Felipe Calderon said during a speech in Houston that while he respects the U.S., he's against statutes like Arizona's controversial law that he believes unfairly go after immigrants.

"I want to be very clear. We are respectful of U.S. sovereignty. But we have to be firmly against those initiatives that tend to criminalize those that are not committing a crime," Calderon said.

SNEAK OF THE MONTH: Hamilton County Sheriff Candidate John Sisson

John Sisson, candidate for Sheriff in Hamilton County, Texas is this month's "Sneak of the Month" for promising to stop enforcing the immigration laws if he is elected.

Sisson opposes the Secure Communities program that allows local law enforcement to compare the fingerprints of arrestees with a national computer database to determine if the individual in question should be deported.

"I was appalled to see what (Secure Communities) was doing to the Hispanic community and the immigrant community here," Sisson said. "I felt like it was very inhumane to be lazy and not do the research and say, 'We'll just hold everybody for deportation and not even mess with the particulars.'"

Three ICE Officers Shot During Massive Drug Operation

Three federal immigration agents were shot and wounded in Petaluma, California while taking part in an anti-gang operation.

The raid was part of a San Francisco Area-wide operation in which federal and local authorities arrested 13 people, most of them alleged gang members, who were indicted on murder, racketeering, conspiracy and other charges.

LeBlanc says that rewarding any group of illegal aliens will encourage even more illegal behavior.

“What Senator Rubio wants to do is limit his amnesty to kids who have lived in the U.S. illegally for a long time,” says LeBlanc. “He thinks that is compassionate. However, all this amnesty will do is encourage more poor parents to sneak across the border, take advantage of America’s lavish welfare benefits and bide their time until their children are old enough to qualify for this amnesty. Frankly, I think that is cruel.”

A more limited version of Amnesty like this one Rubio is proposing will also encourage more and more talk of bigger Amnesties in the future. “If the illegal alien lobby its allies can’t get a complete Amnesty in one piece of legislation, they’ve obviously decided that they will do it incrementally.”

Fast and Furious and is stonewalling the House Government Reform and Oversight Committee. If this isn’t contempt of Congress, I don’t know what is. The House needs to move on this citation and at least start to try to hold Holder accountable.”

The Attorney General has so far failed to comply with all twenty-two categories of Congress’ subpoena requesting documents related to Fast and Furious.

U.S. Representatives Ben Quayle of Arizona, Tim Griffin of Arkansas, Sandy Adams of Florida, Tom Marino of Pennsylvania, Dennis Ross of Florida and Trey Gowdy of South Carolina,

says LeBlanc. “Rubio’s proposal is just the first step down a very slippery slope.”

Despite the Council’s success to date in stopping an Amnesty bill from passing the Senate, defeating a proposal being championed by Marco Rubio will be tough. Rubio’s reputation for being a tough politically-conservative legislator as well as his considerable charm and ability to communicate make him a very formidable foe.

“This is a text-book example of how powerful the illegal alien lobby is,” LeBlanc says. “Here is an up and coming Republican politician who has not even completed two years of service in the Senate and he is willing to risk his entire career to push an Amnesty bill. This is going to be a very tough fight.”

“Eric Holder really needs to be impeached and removed from office,” LeBlanc says. “Over one hundred-twenty members of the House have now publicly called for his resignation, He has no regard for the laws of the United States and the American people lost faith in him years ago if they every trusted him at all. The Council supports passage of contempt charges against Holder as the first step towards removing him from office. And we urge all our supporters across America to tell that their own elected representatives. Eric Holder must go.”

Council Launches Effort to Repeal Tax Loophole for Illegal Aliens

The U.S. Border Security Council is pushing to close a loophole in Federal Tax Code that allows illegal immigrants to receive billions of dollars from the U.S. Government. The Treasury Inspector General only recently discover that illegals were gaming the tax system through the additional child tax credit (ACTC).

The ACTC is designed to give legal U.S. citizens with multiple children up to \$1,000 per child in tax credits each year.

Illegal immigrants, however, are claiming this credit more than five times more often than legal U.S. residents. They are often even claiming children left behind in Mexico as dependents on U.S. tax forms in order to receive the tax credit.

“This is yet another case that show it pays to be an illegal immigrant in the United States,” says Council National Spokesman Steve LeBlanc. “This nonsense must stop and we are going to lobby Congress to close

this loophole and force the Internal Revenue Service to crack down on this type of fraud being perpetrated by illegals.”

LeBlanc says the Committee will start off with a petition on to Congress on its website. Then it may mail launch a nationwide petition drive through the mail.

“The pressure on Congress to fix this issue is already immense,” remarks LeBlanc. “However, if the politicians don't act soon on this, we will.”
