LeBlanc Calls for Campaign Against Super-Citizen Loophole

U.S. Border Security Council National Spokesman Steve Leblanc is demanding Congress act to close an immigration loophole that has created a class of “Super Citizens.”

A recent Center for Immigration Studies report revealed that an increasing number of foreign diplomats stationed in the United States were having children in American hospitals who then became U.S. citizens by virtue of the 14th Amendment to the Constitution. Most disturbingly, these children are also covered by diplomatic

immunity agreements which gives them immunity from prosecution by American authorities.

“We are actually allowing for-

eign diplomats to breed American citizens who are immune from the laws of this country,” Leblanc says. “This Super Citizen loophole must be closed and the Committee will do whatever it takes to make sure that happens.”

“I can foresee a situation in which, down the road, where a diplomat’s teen age kid is able to run wild throughout the country breaking our laws and we can’t even deport him because he is an American citizen,” Leblanc warns. “Diplomats often spend large parts

Council Anti-Amnesty Campaign Forces Obama to Change Strategy

Facing increasingly public opposition to the passage of Amnesty Plus through Congress, President Barack Obama is attempting to circumvent the Constitution and implement amnesty through executive action.

“The President has run into a brick wall in Congress thanks to the outcry from supporters of the U.S. Border Security Council,”

says Steve Leblanc, the Committee’s national spokesman. “Now he is instructing federal law enforcement officials to ignore the law and not prosecute illegal aliens.”

The union representing Immigration and Customs Enforcement agents just recently blew the whistle on the Obama Administration by revealing that the President

Border Security News in Brief

Feds Give 1,400 Guns to Mexican Drug Gangs

Federal agents can't account for more than 1,400 guns that were part of "Operation Fast and Furious." The operation was aimed at tracing the flow of weapons to Mexican drug gangs. Of 2,020 guns involved in the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives probe dubbed only 363 have been recovered in the United States and 227 have been recovered in Mexico.

Amnesty Allies Disagree on "Spotters"

Senator Dick Durbin is calling on churches, synagogues and mosques to lobby their congregation to support the DREAM Act illegal immigration amnesty bill. Durbin is reaching out to the faith community as he tries to advocate for passage of the measure that would grant amnesty to illegal immigrants who attend college or join the military.

DeMint Speaks Out About Border Crisis

An internal Tucson, Arizona police department memo published online warns officers to be aware that Hezbollah terrorists are crossing the U.S. Mexican border. The alarming report follows last year's arrest of Jamal Yousef in New York City that exposed a weapons cache of 100 M-16 assault rifles, 100 AR-15 rifles, 2,500 hand grenades, C4 explosives and antitank munitions that were smuggled into Mexico by an Iranian-backed terror group.

SNEAK OF THE MONTH: Managers at The Washington Post

The entire management team of the left-wing *Washington Post* newspaper is this month's Sneak of the Month.

Post managers deliberately covered up the fact that Jose Antonio Vargas, a Pulitzer prize winning reporter on its staff was an illegal alien.

At least one *Post* senior executive instructed Vargas to continue using a fake Social Security number and fraudulent drivers license in order

of their careers in this country and raise their kids here. This could be a nightmare situation.”

According to the CIS report, American hospitals are allowed to issue U.S. birth certificates to the newborn babies of diplomats and the parents are even allowed to request that their new son or daughter receive a social security number.

“First off, the form that new parents fill out at the hospital needs to be changed so that foreign diplomats cannot get social security numbers for their kids,” Leblanc says. “It is illegal for their kids to receive an American social security number.”

In the long term, Leblanc says the 14th Amendment needs to be changed. “Foreigners are taking advantage of the fact that anyone born on U.S. soil can be an American citizen.”

In addition to solving the problem presented by these “super citizens,” modifying the 14th Amendment would eliminate the issue of anchor babies where illegal alien mothers have children in an American hospital in order to remain in this country. “There is no doubt the 14th Amendment must be changed,” Leblanc concludes.

Obama is up to and we can work to stop this back door amnesty.”

Leblanc says the Council will launch a national grassroots campaign calling for Congressional hearings into this issue. “Our goal has to be to show the American people what the President is doing and then mobilize public opposition,” adds Leblanc. “Hopefully that will stop this new policy.”

If it doesn’t, the Council will ratchet up pressure on Congress to either cut off funding to any federal prosecutor who is not following the law or to start citing the Administration for contempt of Congress. No matter what, we are going to keep fighting Barack Obama.

9,572 Anti-Amnesty Petitions Headed to Capitol Hill

The U.S. Border Security Council recently sent another 9,572 petitions to Capitol Hill opposing amnesty for illegal aliens.

“It is sad that so much time and energy and money has to be spent fighting our own government,” Steve Leblanc, the Committee’s national spokesman says. “However, I’m proud that so many Americans are standing up for our great nation and petitioning our government to secure the borders.”

Most of the petitions direct Congress to vote down S.6, Senator Harry Reid’s Amnesty

Plus proposal.

“There is no doubt in my mind that the thousands and

thousands of petitions we have been gathering have stopped Amnesty from being passed by Congress,” Leblanc explains. “Politicians take notice when stacks of petitions arrive in their offices.

“Still, we have to keep up the pressure,” Leblanc warns. “We must keep bombarding Congress with petitions against amnesty to make sure S.6 is never brought up for a vote.”

The Committee plans to deliver more anti-amnesty petitions to Capitol Hill in the coming weeks.
