House Majority Leader Shocked in Amnesty Related Primary Loss



House Majority Leader Cantor was beaten by Dave Brat based on his immigration stance.

House Majority Leader Eric Cantor (R-VA) was beaten in his primary election by a little known challenger named Dave Brat. Dave Brat, a tea party member, used Congressman Cantor's stance on immigration reform as a vehicle for his upset.

"Congressman Cantor got caught in a tough spot politically, and it ultimately ended up sealing his fate," says U.S. Border Security Council National Spokesman Steven J. Leblanc. "Our members and supporters have been fighting against amnesty for the last ten years adamantly, so I am not that surprised by

U.S. Border Security Council Attends Hearing on Border Security

U.S. Border Security Council National Spokesman Steven J. LeBlanc recently attended a hearing held by the House Committee on Homeland Security, Subcommittee on Border and Maritime Security that examined the procedures that go into securing our southern borders.

Customs and Border Patrol (CBP) Deputy Commissioner Kevin McAleenan and Im-

migrations and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Deputy Director Daniel Ragsdale testified at the hearing on the current state of our borders. Commissioner McAleenan testified that "Today, with 60,000 employees, CBP is one of DHS's largest and most complex components, with a priority mission of keeping terrorists and their weapons out of the United

SNEAK OF THE MONTH: Attorney General Eric Holder Offering Free Legal Representation to Illegal Immigrants Flooding Southern Border

Border Patrol agents have seen a sharp rise in minors making the dangerous trek along the southwest border, with more than 47,000 caught in the first five months of this year, a 92% increase over the same time period in 2013. This drastic increase is due solely to the President and his Administration's lackadaisical immigration enforcement policies. So what is the White House prepared to do to handle this sudden influx of children flooding our southern borders? Give the illegal aliens representation in court.

Attorney General Eric Holder announced on June 6 that The Department of

Justice, working with the Federal Corporation for National and Community Service, will provide \$2 million to entice attorneys and paralegals to represent those young, undocumented immigrants as they navigate the complicated web of immigration courts.

Unlike legal residents, undocumented immigrants aren't guaranteed legal representation in court. Attorney General Holder stated, "We are taking a historic step to strengthen our legal system to protect the most vulnerable people in society." The problem with that

this outcome,” continued LeBlanc, “Americans simply don’t want to grant amnesty to 13 million people that are currently in this country illegally, no matter how they got here.”

Cantor disputed the characterization that he has been wishy-washy on immigration reform by working on legislation to give legal status to young illegal immigrants but also sending out a campaign mailer touting his opposition to “amnesty.” Ultimately though, the people of Virginia’s 7th Congressional district

spoke loud and clear that no form of Amnesty will be accepted.

“I think this will be a referendum in the November elections,” says LeBlanc, “I know it will be for our members and supporters.” The U.S. Border Security Council will continue to pressure members of Congress to resist any deal to grant any pathway towards citizenship and any form of Amnesty.

States. It also has a responsibility for securing the border, approximately 7,000 miles of land borders and 95,000 miles of coastline, and facilitating lawful international trade and travel.”

“It was a pleasure to hear from our men and women on the front lines in the war to secure our borders,” says U.S. Border Security Council National Spokesman Steven J. LeBlanc. “Everyone knows what a tough job CBP and ICE have securing a border that sees on a typical day nearly 1 million travelers, screens more than 67,000 cargo containers, arrests more than 1,100 individuals and seizes nearly 6 tons of illicit drugs.”

The U.S. Border Security Council and its membership are adamant about securing our southern borders. Thanks to the Subcommittee on Border and Maritime Security’s recent hearing, our members and supporters can breathe a little easier knowing that the men and women of CBP and ICE that actually put their boots on the ground on a daily basis are doing the job that the majority of right think-

ing Americans want. “God bless the people that support the U.S. Border Security Council,” says Leblanc, “Without their unwavering support there wouldn’t be a group like ours to keep the politicians in Washington in check, and I thank them for that from the bottom of my heart,” concluded LeBlanc.
