Yet another wave of unaccompanied illegal immigrant children has flooded our southern border via Mexico. It seems that the word has once again spread through Central America that our current President refuses to enforce America's immigration laws. Nearly 17,000 unaccompanied children have already entered America illegally since January 2015.

"These statistics show that the surge of illegal arrivals from Central America was never really over," said Jessica Vaughan, policy studies director at the Center for Immigration Studies.

“I thought the panel made a lot of points that our supporters have been making for years, something has to be done immediately to secure our southern border before any true immigration reform can be discussed,” says LeBlanc. “Congressman Duncan really made some strong points on the importance of upholding and enforcing current immigration laws in America,” continued LeBlanc. “America could sure use a lot more men and women in Congress who share his views.”
