sanctuary can generally be found at schools, churches, hospitals and protests, where Customs and Border Protection agents are barred under a “sensitive locations policy” from carrying out their duty on enforcing border security. According to the Media Research Center, “Almost any illegal alien can escape arrest by either walking with a second person (a march), attending some type of class, or finding a

nearby church, medical facility or school bus stop to evade being detained.”

For his inexcusable and intolerable efforts to uphold the wishes of the Obama administration and continue to undermine the immigration system, as well as his willingness to assist any and all illegal aliens currently residing in America, U.S. Customs and Border Protection Commissioner Gil Kerlikowske is the U.S. Border Security Council’s Sneak of the Month.
