answers at best as to how secure our border is from terrorists,” continued LeBlanc. “The U.S. Border Security Council originally brought this topic to the forefront of the immigration battle nearly two years ago when I asked then Texas Governor Rick Perry if he believed terrorists were using our southern border to infiltrate America, and he said he believes that they are.”

The U.S. Border Security Council has been warning our members and supporters for years. The threat is real. America is exposed. infiltrate the United States in order to commit terrorist acts here,” Judge Richard Posner wrote for the panel. “No evidence of this belief has been presented, however; it is nightmare speculation.” Despite sarcastically blasting Governor Pence’s plan to protect the citizens of Indiana, Judge Posner offered no reassurances or evidence of his own that there would not be terrorists posing as refu-
